



Cal Bellamy Memorial Chilli Cook-off

Information for Contestants

1. All chillies must be homemade by the contestants.
2. Ticket fees are waived for contestants only.
3. Due to capacity at the venue, there is a maximum of 10 contestants for the event; contestant spots will be first-come, first-served.
4. Contestants must supply a large slow cooker of chilli—enough to serve 50-75 small samples—a stirring spoon, and a ladle to serve their chilli.
5. Bytown Lodge will provide paper cups and spoons for sampling, condiments, extension chords and power bars, tables, chairs, tablecloths, trophies and prizes.
6. Trophies will be awarded in three categories: Best Traditional Chilli, Most Creative Chilli, and Best Overall Chilli.
7. The judge's scores will determine the winners in the Best Traditional and the Most Creative categories.
8. The audience will determine the winner for Best Overall Chilli. Each chilli will be assigned a number; the audience will sample the chillies, and cast their vote by recording the number of their favourite chilli on their ballot.
9. Contestants will not serve their own chilli—they will be randomly assigned another chilli to serve so the audience won't know who made which chilli.
10. Contestants may vote the same as the audience.
11. Winners will be announced near the end of the event.
12. Event proceeds will be donated to the Ottawa District 2 charity.
